



FAVARGER VISITS "WEDNESDAYS AT THE MANUFACTURE"

Founded in 1826, Favarger is the oldest chocolate manufacturer in Switzerland to roast cocoa beans. It commands the whole chocolate-making process: selecting the cocoa beans and other ingredients; roasting; crushing; grinding; blending; temperature control; moulding and other decorations; packaging; and dispatching.

The Favarger Manufacture would be delighted to give you an insight into the chocolate making profession during a visit to its production site and to demonstrate its manufacturing processes.

Visits take place every Wednesday from 9.00am to 11.30am and from 1.30pm to 4.30pm. They last about 1 hour and cost 25CHF for adults and 15CHF for children. The guided visit includes explanations about the whole of the production process as well as a selection of chocolates to sample.

Visits can be carried out in French, English, German or other languages upon request.

We would be grateful if you could return the form below with your personal details, your proposed date and time of arrival as well as the number of visitors (between 8 and 40 people, split into groups of 10). Your request must reach us as early as possible (minimum 3 weeks before the visit). Places are limited and assigned according to the date of receipt of the request.

Payments are made at the beginning of the visit by cash or credit card. Invoices can be supplied upon request (only for groups).
